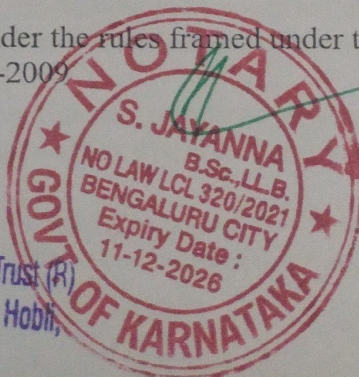

Conditions:

The school is registered under the Child Rights Education Act-2009, and the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and in accordance with the rules framed thereunder, and the accreditation is renewed up to the registered class. Apart from these classes, additional classes and extra sections are not permitted.

1. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the Child Rights Education Act-2009

2. Child Rights to Education Act-2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed thereunder. The Government has the authority to enroll the reserved seats under RTE for the schools covered by RTE. [Government has formulated rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in neighboring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government and government-funded educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school] Otherwise, private schools will enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. To enable these children to continue their studies without any discrimination.

3. Fees of children enrolled under RTE rules as described in Condition: 3 will be released by the Government as per rules. Hence it has stopped charging any fees from these children.

4. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of enrollment or later.

5. The school / management body shall publish information on the fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fees vide State Government Notification No: ED:31:PGC:2019, dated:27.07.2019 on the departmental website and on the school notice board. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.

6. The School / Governing Body shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.

7. Carrying out all safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire safety and building safety certificate from concerned authorities and child learning safety as per KSCPCR and NCPCR].

The School / Governing Body is as follows

1. No admitted child shall be retained in any class or expelled from the school until he completes primary education and secondary education in the school.

2. Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule-21 and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

3. As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules the school shall also admit children with special needs / special children.

4. Appointed teachers shall possess the minimum qualifications as prescribed for primary and high school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.

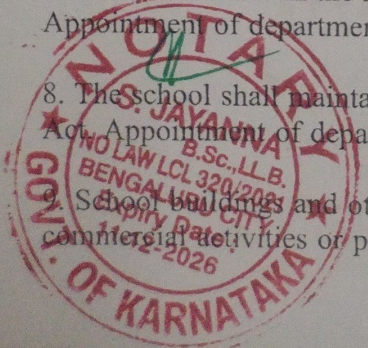
5. Salary and allowances payable to teachers and terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And salaries are paid to teachers through government notification [Prospective Fund (P)] and payable to bank and other salaries. and subject to Employee State Insurance (ESI).

6. Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section-24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule-17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.

7. Adherence to the academic state curriculum and state text books to which the school is affiliated. 12. The school shall maintain the norms and standards as specified in Section-19 of the Karnataka Education Act. Appointment of departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

8. The school shall maintain the norms and standards as specified in Section-19 of the Karnataka Education Act. Appointment of departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

9. School buildings and other basic facilities related to the school should not to be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.



10. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
11. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and Submit the copy to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
12. The School shall follow the Language Policy as per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy-2016].
13. Governing body and teachers to act as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
14. The school / governing body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department.
15. Mandatory regular updating of school information in SATS by the end of March every year.
16. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
17. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document/information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
18. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.

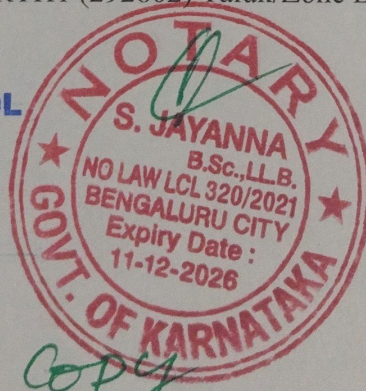
